Any charities registered in the UK...

...can benefit from 0.5% of the net purchase price of items bought via smile.amazon.co.uk (excluding VAT, returns and shipping fees).



How it works

In order to participate, organisations must be registered and in good standing with the Charity Commission of either England, Wales, Scotland or Northern Ireland.

There are five steps that organisations need to take to enrol to receive donations. This process must be done by an official representative of the organisation. To find out how to enrol [click here](#).

To be able to shop, customers must first select a charity. Amazon will donate 0.5% of the net purchase (excluding VAT, returns and shipping).



Will it cost you anything?

No. There is no cost to either charitable organisations or to Amazon Smile customers. There is no charge to participate and Amazon do not deduct any fees from the donation amount.

Charities must have a valid bank account to enable Amazon to direct payments to.



Donations

Each quarter, Amazon makes donations to eligible charitable organisations by electronic funds transfer.

The minimum amount an organisation must accrue to receive a quarterly donation is £5.00. Unfortunately Amazon do not currently have a reporting function for donations received.
